***Please DO NOT book flights and/or hotel or make any travel reservations until you have paid in full and have completed your registration and you have received confirmation on the SportsEngine registration site.** Athletes must also upload a completed pre-participation doctor clearance form. See the SportsEngine registration site for the document and instructions on how to upload your completed document into SportsEngine. In the event you are unable to upload your pre-participation doctor clearance form into SportsEngine, please bring a hard copy of the form to on-site registration in San Antonio. Athletes who do not upload or cannot produce a completed pre-participation doctor clearance form will not be eligible to participate in the Navy National Combine.

Registration:

Registration will close once each position is filled or Monday, December 22, 2025, whichever occurs first. Athletes are only permitted to register for and participate in one position. There are no Kicker, Punter, or Long Snapper positions available in the Navy National Combine.

2026 NAVY NATIONAL COMBINE TESTING INFORMATION

The Navy National Combine uses the Standardized Athlete Test (SAT®) for the body measurements and physical tests. The results of the SAT® show how each athlete compares by graduation year and position to other athletes around the country. The SAT® also shows what the average college athlete performs at by position.

Body Measurements

- Height, weight, reach, wingspan, and hand size

Physical Tests

- 40 Yard Dash with 10 and 20-yard splits
- Pro Agility Shuttle (20-Yard Shuttle: 5-10-5)
- Vertical Jump
- Broad Jump

The position-specific drills highlight the athlete's skill. Position drills allow players to demonstrate their ability in fundamental skill areas necessary for their position.

Position Drills

- **Quarterback**
QB's throw to TE's, RB's and WR's during 1-on-1 pass coverage
- **Running Back/Linebacker**
RB's run routes against LB's in 1-on-1 pass coverage
- **Tight End**
TE's run routes against LB's in 1-on-1 pass coverage
- **Wide Receiver/Defensive Back**
WR's run routes against DB's in 1-on-1 pass coverage
- **Offensive/Defensive Line**
OL/DL perform agility drills and 1-on-1 pass block vs. pass rush
OL/DL perform agility drills and 1-on-1 run block vs. run fit

3. Athletes should bring their own cleats and gloves. The Navy National Combine will take place on an artificial turf field surface.
5. Athletes are responsible for their own transportation from the San Antonio airport to the Hyatt Regency San Antonio Riverwalk, where registration will take place.
6. Athletes are required to supply their own lodging and transportation to/from the hotel and the Alamodome.
7. **Athletes and families should not book any travel before the athletes are paid in full and officially registered and have received confirmation on the registration site.**
