

NASCAR Cup Series Championship Fast Facts

Driver Champion: Kyle Larson Team: No. 5 Hendrick Motorsports Chevrolet

- Kyle Larson has won his second NASCAR Cup Series Championship (2021, 2025). He is one of 36 different drivers to win a Cup Series title, and the 18th different driver to win multiple championships.
- Larson finished third in the NASCAR Cup Series season finale at Phoenix Raceway to claim the title.
- In 36 starts this season, Larson has posted three wins, 15 top fives, 22 top 10s and one pole.
- During the Playoffs this season, Byron has put up four top fives, and six top 10s in 10 starts.
- Kyle Larson, from Elk Grove, California, is one of four NASCAR Cup Series Champions from the state of California; alongside Kevin Harvick (Bakersfield), and NASCAR Hall of Famers Jeff Gordon (Vallejo) and Jimmie Johnson (El Cajon).

Owner Champion: Hendrick Motorsports

- This is Hendrick Motorsports' record 15th NASCAR Cup Series driver championship, the most all-time in the series (2025, '21, '20, '16, '13, '10, '09, '08, '07, '06, '01, '98, '97, '96, '95).
- This is Hendrick Motorsports' record 15th NASCAR Cup Series owner championship, the most all-time in the series (2025, '21, '20, '16, '13, '10, '09, '08, '07, '06, '01, '98, '97, '96, '95). This is the first time the organization has won a split driver/owner championships.
- This is Hendrick Motorsports' 18th NASCAR national series owner championship, extending its all-time record (15 Cup, three CRAFTSMAN Truck, 2001,'99, '97).
- Hendrick Motorsports was the first team to win five consecutive championships (Jimmie Johnson, 2006-2010). It was also the first to win four straight, from 1995-98 (Jeff Gordon, 1995 and 1997-98; Terry Labonte, 1996).
- Hendrick Motorsports has won 320 NASCAR Cup Series races (series-most) leading 20 different drivers to Victory Lane Geoffrey Bodine, Tim Richmond, Darrell Waltrip, Ken Schrader, Ricky Rudd, Jeff Gordon, Terry Labonte, Jerry Nadeau,
 Jimmie Johnson, Joe Nemechek, Kyle Busch, Brian Vickers, Casey Mears, Dale Earnhardt Jr., Mark Martin, Kasey Kahne,
 Chase Elliott, Alex Bowman, William Byron and Kyle Larson.
- Hendrick Motorsports began its NASCAR Cup Series program in 1984 at Daytona International Speedway with driver Geoffrey Bodine.

Crew Chief Champion: Cliff Daniels

- Cliff Daniels has won his second NASCAR Cup Series Championship with driver Kyle Larson (2021, 2025).
- Daniels is one of 43 different crew chiefs in the NASCAR Cup Series to win a championship, and the 17th different crew chief to win multiple titles.
- Daniels has 25 career NASCAR Cup Series wins all with driver Kyle Larson.
